Master hair design graduates' placement opportunities include: beauty salons, resort hotels, or have the opportunity to own their own salon.

Program description:

Master Aesthetician

The Master Aesthetician Program prepares students for employment as licensed professionals in the growing and competitive skin care industry. Students in this program will learn and develop proficiencies in basic skin care, advance esthetics, pre and post-operative skin care, spa body treatments, cosmetic and corrective permanent makeup, sanitation and infection control, applicable rules and regulations and business practices.

Master Hair Design

The Master Hair Design Program prepares students for employment as licensed professionals in the growing and competitive hair styling and design industry. Students in this program will learn and develop proficiencies in skin and nail practices, hair design theory and concepts, hair cleaning and shampooing, hair coloring, chemical applications and permanent reconstructions, hair anatomy and physiology, scalp diseases and treatments, wig and hairpiece fitting, hair braiding, hair extensions, hair straightening, Vidal Sassoon cutting and coloring, customer service, shop management, equipment operation, health and safety, and applicable laws and regulations.
